

October 1st- Your Contract has begun.

No Seed purchases, site prep, or expenses will be cost-shared before **October 1st**.

Remove Crop ASAP

Fall Tillage is Discouraged and Not Necessary

Do Not Apply Fall Burn Down with chemical Residual

Order your Seed according to the **NRCS 327 Job Sheet**

Fall Seeding

Seeding can take place **November 15th- March 1st** for Fall Seeding

Seeding should be No-till or broadcast

Tillage is Discouraged and Not Necessary

Multiple Applications of Glyphosate can be applied to control weeds ahead of planting

Mow no shorter than 12", vegetation should be mowed only to suppress seed heads of weeds and never mowed when vegetation exceeds 12" high

Spring Seeding

Seeding can take place **March 1st- June 5th** for Spring Seeding

Important Notes and Information

- Broadcast seeding rates should be adjusted, additionally do not use Nitrogen based fertilizers as a carrier in a broadcast seeding.
- April 15th- August 1st are the Primary Nesting Season Dates
- No Mowing should take place on CRP projects without approval of the NRCS-Natural Resource Conservation Service
- All invoices for the first year of establishment must be returned as soon as the project has been installed.
- All projects are randomly inspected for compliance
- Compliance includes seeding specifications, woody encroachment, mowing, crop encroachment, etc.

*****Planting Success isn't measured until the 3rd growing season**
Flowering Plants should be visible in Year 2 but very visible year 3.***
