## ~Financials/Minutes:

Sally motioned to approve the July minutes as written. Jeff seconded. Motion carried. Sally made a motion to approve August checks, Jeff seconded. Motion carried. Jeff made a motion to approve the Financials as written. Sally seconded. Motion carried.

~Jackie gave the Watershed report as written: Lake Bloomington Shoreline Protection Project was completed on July 14. A motion was made by Jeff to approve payment to Boyle Excavating Inc. (\$209,903.00) and Midwest Streams (\$18,529.82). Sally seconded. Motion carried. Met with BNWRD for a 319 grant for Sugar Creek watershed plan. Mike Strubhar will be conducting the district audit review again this year.

~Brett gave the District report as written: CPP Waterway of Doug Thompson is complete and should be sending in bills soon. Jack Pitts has decided to drop out of CPP funding for this fiscal year. Jeff motioned to approve a new waterway project for Elizabeth Peacock LLC, and also motioned to maintain CPP cost share payment cap of \$10,000 dollars for FY21 funds. Sally seconded both of these motions. Motions carried.

**Ross gave the Watershed report as written:** August E-Newsletter campaign has been distributed. Jim Rutherford golf outing was rescheduled from August 2 to August 9 due to inclement weather. Grant application for pollinator project at Lake Bloomington has been approved.

**~Adam gave the NRCS report:** 6 additional CSP applications have been approved for funding (3 in McLean). Illinois was awarded an additional 2 million dollars to fund these applications. 3 RCPP applications have been pre-approved for funding. CRP re-enrolls are nearly complete in McLean.
