Individual Species– Priced by PLS (Pure Live Seed)	Price/lb
Black-eyed Susan – Excellent choice for prairie restorations, or the first-year planting of a wildflower garden. Mature heights of 1- 2 feet tall. Blooms primarily from early to mid-summer.	\$26
Red Clover – great for inter-seeding, pasture, and cool season stands. Short lived perennial, 2-3 years with the most aggressive growth in the spring.	\$5
Indian Grass (Tomahawk) - long lived, warm season grass, that spreads by seed. Grows 4-8 feet tall, provides excellent wildlife cover.	\$15
Switchgrass (Cave n Rock) - Late maturing prairie grass, grows best in fertile, well-drained soils. Mature heights 5 feet +.	\$24
Big Bluestem (Bison) - Grows well on a variety of soil types, reaches heights of 7 to 9 feet tall.	\$16

- Do-Not work the ground
- No-till/Broadcast for best results
- Planting area must be bare ground
- SWCD Equipment available to rent
- Plant before June 1st
- Blend with Oats or Crack-Corn
- Mixes fully establish in 3 years
- Mow above seedlings in Year 1
- Only mow at maximum heights, with minimum windrows
